
Calendar non - domestic waste (commercial) San Lorenzo



Shops, craftsmen, bars and restaurants, fruit shops, florists, schools with canteen. (...)



DO NOT LEAVE WASTE ON THE STREET OR OUTSIDE OF THE BINS

New rule

Any violation of proper waste disposal will result in fines under the current legislation.

Paper and card

Paper and card bags; newspapers; books; notebooks and magazines... (clean without adhesive, metal or plastic).

Put the waste in the white container, use paper bags

Cardboard packaging

Clean cardboard without adhesive, metal or plastic... (flattened and piled up on the ground).

Plastic and metal packaging (free of any residue)

Plastie: bottles; disposable plastic plates and cups; beverage and food cartons (milk and fruit juice cartons...) polystyrene; rigid and flexible bags, sacks and packaging for food; plastic or cellophane film; bottles for household and personal hygiene products; nets and crates for fruit and vegetables; clothes hangers...

Metal (steel and aluminium): cans for drinks and oil tins; trays for cooking and storing food; tins; aluminium foils; caps; aerosol cans that are not classified as hazardous material...

Use semi-transparent bags to facilitate the check of the contents of the bags

Glass packaging

Bottles, pots, vials and jars free of any residue and metal caps.

Put the waste in the green container, without the bag

Organic waste

Kitchen waste; food scarps; spoiled food; eggshells; coffee grounds and pods; tea and chamomile bags; cut flowers; leaves of house plants; stale bread; paper napkins; wood ashes; corks; kitchen towels; wooden fruit crates (broken); fruit stones; pizza boxes (chopped up); cutlery; plates and cups made of compostable bioplastic...

Put the waste in the brown container, use compostable bioplastic bags

Non-recyclable waste

Dirty paper, greasy paper, baking and glazed paper; broken plates and glasses; ceramics; toys without electronic components; CDs and DVDs; nappies; sanitary towels; receipts; basins; foam rubber; incandescent and halogen bulbs; scans and photographic film; disposable razors; umbrellas...

Put the waste in the grey container

Bulky waste and WEEE (electric and electronic equipment out of service) Mattresses; furniture; large and small household appliances; computers; TVs...

Collection will be done by 2 pm the following day

You can delivery your waste to the municipal waste collection centres (CCR)*. Find your nearest.
